Commencement Ceremony Schedule

NO LATER THAN 7:30 a.m.	Students only (no family or friends) report to assigned rooms in ICC / WGR for check-in and lineup. <i>(IF SEVERE WEATHER CALL IS MADE - see below)</i>
~ 8:05 a.m.	Students are led out to Red Square area for formation to prepare for the Procession to Healy Lawn
8:30 a.m.	Procession to Healy Lawn begins
9:00 a.m.	Commencement Ceremony begins on Healy Lawn <i>(IF SEVERE WEATHER CALL IS MADE - see below)</i>
10:45 a.m.	Commencement Ceremony on Healy Lawn concludes; students exit Healy Lawn as follows: - <i>All PhD Students are led to the sidewalk in front of Copley Hall and dismissed from there.</i>

- All **Master's Students** are led past Old North, through the Tunnel, to Dahlgren Chapel (rear of Healy Hall) and dismissed from there.

Note: The GSAS-IS Interdisciplinary Program students continue past Dahlgren Chapel, down to Leo O'Donovan Hall, and then up Prospect Street to the Car Barn for additional activities. Their guests should go directly from Healy Lawn out Healy Main Gate (37th Street and O Street) to the Car Barn (3520 Prospect Street at 36th Street).

Some programs have additional activities planned for later in the day.

OVERFLOW VIEWING AREAS FOR GUESTS: Guests who are unable to sit on Healy Lawn may view the Graduate School Commencement Ceremony on display screens located **inside Maguire Hall, in Rooms 101 and 103**. NO BAG STORAGE AT LINEUP: Please note that there is **NO** baggage storage or coat check at Friday's Lineup in WGR or ICC, or during the Graduate School Commencement Ceremony. You **may not** leave anything in the Lineup rooms – you will **not** be returning there, and another School will already be using those rooms to line up for their ceremony by the time you exit your Commencement ceremony. Any items left or found in the Lineup rooms (or on Healy Lawn) will be turned in to the **main University Lost & Found at the Wheelchair Booth near Healy Gate**.

LOST AND FOUND: Items left in the Lineup rooms, Red Square, or on Healy Lawn will be taken to the University Commencement Lost & Found located in the **Wheelchair Booth near Healy Main Gate**.

Beginning Monday, May 20, all items found during Commencement Week will be found at the GU Police Department Lost & Found Office, located in Village C, Ground Floor (across from Healy Family Student Center / SW Quad).

In Case of Severe Weather...

The Graduate School Commencement Ceremony will be held on Healy Lawn **RAIN or SHINE**. ONLY in the event of extreme, **severe weather conditions** (electrical storm, dangerous winds, etc.) will the University move the event from Healy Lawn to McDonough Arena. Students and faculty will be notified officially by email and on the website if this occurs (*see below*). If it is raining, but not severe, students and guests should be prepared to walk, march, and sit in the rain (some will be covered by the Healy Lawn tents).

The overall morning schedule will remain the same even if the Commencement Ceremony is moved to McDonough Arena. A severe weather call will be made by the University no later than **6:00 a.m. on Friday morning**. The Georgetown University Commencement website will be updated immediately to reflect the change (<http://commencement.georgetown.edu>), and an email / text will be sent to all graduating students, staff, and faculty. Students are responsible for notifying their family, friends, and guests of any venue changes.

In the event of an **OFFICIAL** severe weather call, **instead** of reporting to ICC or White-Gravenor for check-in, robing and lineup, all students will **instead** report to the Lineup Tent in front of McDonough Arena **by 7:30 a.m.**

- **Master's students** will check-in by alphabetical last name at the front desks in the McDonough Lineup Tent by **7:30 a.m.** to get their lineup card with seat number and then seat themselves in the appropriate labelled chair in the Lineup tent.
- **Ph.D. students** check-in at the special Ph.D. Check-in Desk in the front of the McDonough Lineup tent to get their lineup card, and they will then go directly inside to the McDonough Arena **West Hallway by 7:30 a.m.** for check-in and lineup there.
- **Faculty and Stage Platform Party** will report directly inside to McDonough Arena **East Hallway by 8:00 a.m.** There, faculty will check-in and receive further lineup and seating instructions. Faculty should arrive wearing their regalia.

Please note that there is **NO** bag storage or coat check at the McDonough Lineup tent or during the Graduate School Commencement on Friday morning. You may **NOT** leave anything in the Lineup tent or other areas – you will not be returning there, and another school will already be lining up there by the time you exit your Commencement ceremony inside the tent.

If McDonough Arena is used in the event of severe weather, each graduate has been allocated **ONLY 5** seat tickets, which must be presented at the door by the graduate's guests (either paper print out or scannable code). All guests in a group must enter together in the same group. Each graduate was limited to 5 tickets previously allotted. No other guests will be admitted inside McDonough Arena. Other viewing areas that do not require tickets will be located in the Student Lineup tent outside of McDonough Arena, where there will be large monitors displaying the Graduate School Commencement Ceremony.
